Note: Classes will run from 1:40 – 2:40 pm on minimum days. Friday min days: Oct 19 & 26, and Mar 22 & 29. Mon min days: Oct 22 and Mar 25 \* Students generally progress from one level to the next unless the Spanish teacher informs you that your child would benefit by repeating a course. If you have questions about what level your child should enroll in, please call the director.

How do children get to the class? Children meet the teacher at the assigned classroom.

<u>What happens at the end of the class</u>? Parents pick up the children at the classroom. Otherwise they are walked to Child Care/Day Care.

## Safety Guidelines for Aviara Oaks Elementary School - After School program

- 1. It is the responsibility of the parents to assure their child knows where to go and can get to their after-school class by themselves.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the After-school Vendor to assure the safety of each student in his/her class.
- 3. It is, again, the responsibility of the parents to either pick the student up from the after school class or to assure that the child knows to go directly to the after-school child care classroom. It is not the responsibility of the After-school vendor to walk a child to the parent's car or to child care.
- 4. It is not the responsibility of AOE staff to assure the safety of students after school has been released if they are signed up for an after-school enrichment class.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the parents to provide a main contact number where they can be reached in case a child doesn't show up to class or there is an emergency.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the parents to inform the Spanish teacher or the director that their child will be absent from class.
- If you think your child is not responsible enough to get to their After-School Enrichment class, please reconsider signing them up for classes.
