\* Year 1A and Year 1B are both beginning Spanish courses with the same vocabulary themes, but we teach Year 1B with higher level songs, activities, and a more advanced workbook. Students in 1<sup>st</sup> grade should enroll in Year 1B Spanish even if they took Year 1A as Kindergarteners. Students generally progress from one level to the next unless the Spanish teacher informs you that your child would benefit by repeating a course. If you have questions about what level your child should enroll in, please call the director.

**How do children get to the class?** AM Kindergarteners – school teacher will drop off the AM Kindergarteners at the assigned classroom on her way to the KOC pick up area. PM Kindergarteners – Parents drop off the children at the assigned classroom. OLDER CHILDREN meet the teacher at the assigned classroom.

**What happens at the end of the class?** AM Kindergarteners – Parents may pick up their children at the assigned classroom or, after Spanish teacher walks with the children to deliver KOC students to KOC, she will walk the remaining students to the pick up area just outside the kindergarten playground. PM Kindergarteners – Spanish teacher walks the children to their classrooms. OLDER CHILDREN – The Spanish teacher drops off the KOC students on the way to the front of the school. Parents pick the children up in front of the black gate at the front of the school.
