* **Year 1A and Year 1B are both beginning Spanish courses** with the same vocabulary themes, but we teach Year 1B at a higher level with higher level songs, workbook, and activities. Students generally progress from one level to the next unless the Spanish teacher informs you that your child would benefit by repeating a course. If you have questions about what level your child should enroll in, please call the director. Year 2 and 3 Spanish are excellent starting Spanish courses for students who speak Spanish at home but have never had any formal instruction.

How do children get to the class? Children meet the teacher at the assigned classroom. Kindergarteners will be picked up from their classrooms and walked to the assigned classroom. **On the first day, children meet teacher at the lunch arbor and they walk to the assigned classroom together.**

What happens at the end of the class? Parents pick up the children at the classroom. Otherwise they are walked to the YMCA.
