Instructions: Practice verb conjugation by filling out the table below. Do these in class and then study them for homework. The answers are shown in the **Answer Key** at the back of the workbook.

Present	<i>I entertain</i>	<i>She comes</i>	<i>You appear/seem</i>
Past	<i>You accompanied</i>	<i>I found</i>	<i>He entertained</i>
Present Perfect	<i>He has found</i>	<i>You have accompanied</i>	<i>They have forgotten</i>
Progressive	<i>We are forgetting</i>	<i>They are entertaining</i>	<i>You (formal) are begging</i>
Command	<i>Don't beg</i>	<i>Forget it (ref. to "el sueño")</i>	<i>Find them (ref. to "las llaves")</i>
Future	<i>They will appear/seem</i>	<i>We will prefer</i>	<i>I will accompany</i>
Helper Verb + Infinitive	<i>You (plural) are going to prefer</i>	<i>I don't want to beg</i>	<i>You can come</i>

Key Verbs	acompañar (to accompany) <i>Regular</i>	entretener (to entertain) <i>Irregular (like "tener")</i>	parecerse, reflexive (to seem, to appear) <i>Irregular (like "conocer")</i>	rogar (to beg or plead) <i>Irregular, stem-changing</i>
	encontrar (to find) <i>Irregular, stem-changing</i>	olvidar (to forget) <i>Regular</i>	preferir (to prefer) <i>Irregular, stem-changing</i>	venir* (to come) <i>Irregular, stem-changing</i>

* Irregular spelling. Present: *Yo vengo, tú vienes, él viene, nosotros venimos, ellos vienen.* Past: *Yo vine, tú veniste, él vino, nosotros venimos, ellos vinieron*
