^{*} Year 1A and Year 1B are both beginning Spanish courses with the same vocabulary themes, but we teach Year 1B at a higher level with higher level songs, workbook, and activities. Students generally progress from one level to the next unless the Spanish teacher informs you that your child would benefit by repeating a course. If you have questions about what level your child should enroll in, please call the director. Year 2 Spanish is an excellent starting Spanish course for students who speak Spanish at home but have never had any formal instruction.

<u>How do students get to the class</u>? Kindergarten students are picked up from their classrooms right outside of Room 24 by 2:07 PM. All other students meet the teacher at the assigned classroom.

What happens at the end of the class? Parents pick up students at the classroom. Students enrolled in child care will be walked to Prime Time/ICES when class is over. If a parent is late picking up a child, the teacher will wait with the child right outside the school office. This allows the office staff to communicate with the Spanish teacher if a parent calls saying they will be late. Please pick up your child on time as teachers often have commitments after the class is over.
