
Instructions: Color the items as stated in the sentence. Read each sentence out loud at least 2 times.


La manzana es ROJA.




El mono es CAFÉ.

Las uvas son MORADAS.




El delfín es GRIS.



El cocodrilo es VERDE.




El flamingo es ROSADO.

Note: Colors ending in the letter “o,” like in “morado,” change the ending vowel to “a” if the color describes a noun that has “la” as the article. Example: La uva es morada. If the noun is plural, the color ends in “s.” Example: Las uvas son moradas.
